## A. The definition of "Application" is deleted and replaced with the following:

3. "Application" means the application for a Renewable Energy Approval dated October 28, 2014, and signed by Allan Gustafson, President, Sagatay Cogeneration LP, and all supporting documentation submitted with the application, including amended documentation submitted up to December 23, 2015; and as further amended by the application for an amendment to a Renewable Energy Approval dated March 31, 2018, and signed by David Mackett, Board Member, Sagatay Cogeneration LP, and all supporting documentation submitted with the application, including amended documentation submitted up to October 31, 2018; and as further amended by the application for an amendment to a Renewable Energy Approval dated October 4, 2021, and signed by David Mackett, Board Member, Sagatay Cogeneration LP, and all supporting documentation submitted with the application, including amended documentation submitted up to the date this amendment to the Renewable Energy Approval is issued;

## B. Condition B1 is deleted and replaced with the following:

B1. Construction and installation of the Facility must be completed within three (3) years of the later of:

- (1) the date this amendment to the Approval is issued; or
- (2) if there is a hearing or other litigation in respect of the issuance of this amendment to the Approval, the date that this hearing or litigation is disposed of, including all appeals.

All other Terms and Conditions of the Approval remain the same.

This Notice shall constitute part of the approval issued under Approval No. 4623-9W7K5Q dated December 23, 2015

In accordance with Section 139 of the *Environmental Protection Act*, within 15 days after the service of this notice, you may by further written notice served upon the Director, the Ontario Land Tribunal and the Minister of the Environment, Conservation and Parks, require a hearing by the Tribunal.

In accordance with Section 47 of the *Environmental Bill of Rights*, 1993, the Minister of the Environment, Conservation and Parks will place notice of your request for a hearing on the Environmental Registry.

Section 142 of the *Environmental Protection Act* provides that the notice requiring the hearing shall state:

- a. The portions of the renewable energy approval or each term or condition in the renewable energy approval in respect of which the hearing is required, and;
- b. The grounds on which you intend to rely at the hearing in relation to each portion appealed.
