The reason(s) for this refusal is (are) as follows:

In our letter dated November 15, 2021 to 1712833 Ontario Limited, we requested

technical information to be submitted for the assessment for approval of the application. However, the we did not receive the requested information by the deadline of November 30, 2020. The Director, in accordance with Section 9(4) of the Act, uses his/her authority to refuse to issue a certificate of approval for the application.

In accordance with Section 139 of the *Environmental Protection Act*, you may by written notice served upon me, the Ontario Land Tribunal and in accordance with Section 47 of the *Environmental Bill of Rights*, 1993, the Minister of the Environment, Conservation and Parks, within 15 days after receipt of this notice, require a hearing by the Tribunal. The Minister of the Environment, Conservation and Parks will place notice of your appeal on the Environmental Registry. Section 142 of the *Environmental Protection Act* provides that the notice requiring the hearing ("the Notice") shall state:

- a. The grounds on which you intend to rely at the hearing considering your appeal.

The Notice should also include:

1. The name of the appellant;
2. The address of the appellant;
3. The application reference number;
4. The name of the Director;

And the Notice should be signed and dated by the appellant.
