May 4, 2018 for a Class 4 wind facility , as follows:*

A. The definition of "Application" is deleted and replaced with the following:

12. "Application" means the application for a Renewable Energy Approval dated July 18, 2017, and signed by Kenneth Little, Senior Project Manager, Nation Rise Wind Farm Limited Partnership, and all supporting documentation submitted with the application, including amended documentation submitted up to the date this Approval is issued; and as further amended by the application for an amendment to a Renewable Energy Approval dated April 8, 2019, and signed by Thomas LoTurco, Director of Development, Nation Rise Wind Farm Limited Partnership, and all supporting documentation submitted with the Application, including amended documentation submitted up to June 14, 2019; and as further amended by the application an amendment to the Renewable Energy Approval dated December 13, 2021, and signed by Kenneth Little, Director of Project Manager, Nation Rise Wind Farm Limited Partnership, and all supporting documentation submitted with the Application;

B. Condition E3 in the Approval is deleted and replaced with the following:

E3. The Company shall carry out an Acoustic Audit - Transformer Substation and shall submit to the Director and the District Manager an Acoustic Audit Report – Transformer Substation prepared by an Independent Acoustical Consultant, in accordance with Ministry Publication NPC-233, "Information to be Submitted for Approval of Stationary Sources of Sound", October, 1995 as amended, and no later than twelve (12) months after the commencement of the operation of the Facility.

The reason(s) for this amendment to the Approval is (are) as follows:

18. Condition E3 is included to require the Company to gather accurate information so that the environmental noise impact and subsequent compliance with the Act, O. Reg. 359/09, the Noise Guidelines for Wind Farms and this Approval can be verified.

All other Terms and Conditions remain the same.

This Notice shall constitute part of the approval issued under Approval No. 0871-AV3TFM dated May 4, 2018

In accordance with Section 139 of the *Environmental Protection Act*, within 15 days after the service of this notice, you may by further written notice served upon the Director, the Ontario Land Tribunal and the Minister of the Environment, Conservation and Parks, require a hearing by the Tribunal.

In accordance with Section 47 of the *Environmental Bill of Rights*, 1993, the Minister of the Environment, Conservation and Parks will place notice of your request for a hearing on the Environmental Registry.

Section 142 of the *Environmental Protection Act* provides that the notice requiring the hearing shall state:

- a. The portions of the renewable energy approval or each term or condition in the renewable energy approval in respect of which the hearing is required, and;
- b. The grounds on which you intend to rely at the hearing in relation to each portion appealed.

1. The name of the appellant;
2. The address of the appellant;
3. The renewable energy approval number;
4. The date of the renewable energy approval;
5. The name of the Director;
6. The municipality or municipalities within which the project is to be engaged in;
