At this time, the intention is to create a Class 1 Sewage Treatment System - Pit Privy (Outhouse). Contact has been made with the Thunder Bay Health Unit regarding this system and all construction recommendations and guidelines will be followed. While full septic systems are not being considered at this time, the proposed lot sizes are suitable for such systems in the future. The Health Unit will inspect our property following formal approval.

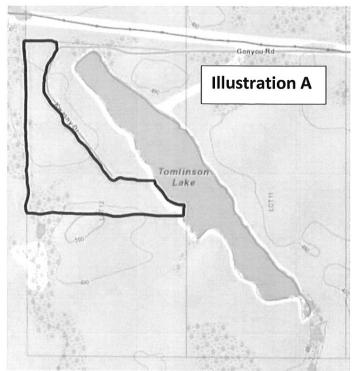

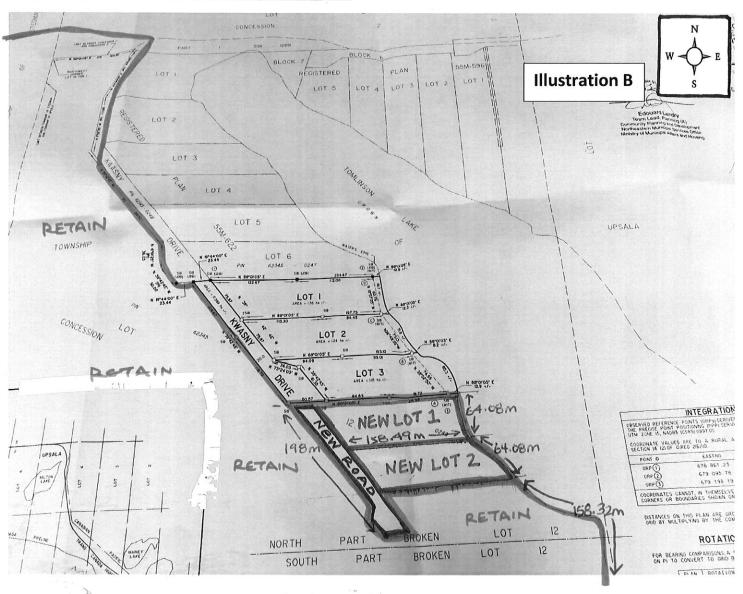
