Dear ENQIAO ZHANG,

Fuels Safety Division acknowledges receipt of your application for variance from the Liquid Fuels Handling Code, Technical Standards & Safety Act R.S.O. 2000. Your proposal regarding replacing tank and dispenser sump entry boots with retrofit boots made by Icon Products has been posted on the Environmental Registry (<https://ero.ontario.ca/notice/019-6507>) for a minimum of 30 days to permit public participation in its assessment. No decision will be made on your proposal until the public participation period has expired and all comments received on the proposal have been considered in the decision-making process. Posting on the Environmental Registry is a requirement placed on TSSA pursuant to Part 1, Section 1 of O. Reg. 180/98 under the Environmental Bill of Rights.

The posting of your proposal will permit the public the opportunity to review and submit comments on the proposal. After the public participation process is complete and all submitted comments have been considered, the public will be notified of the decision regarding your proposal by the posting of a decision file on the Environmental Registry. The public will have a right to seek leave to appeal the decision for a period of 15 days following the decision file posting.

Where a member of the public seeks leave to appeal from a decision, the application for leave to appeal will be posted on the Environmental Registry. The Director appointed under the Technical Standards & Safety Act R.S.O. 2000, as the appellate body, will not proceed with the application for leave to appeal until 15 days after the notice is posted on the Registry.

In order to provide fair and adequate representation from private and public interests involved in the application for leave to appeal, the Director may permit any person to participate in the appeal process.
