


Proposed Uxbridge Urban Provincial Park PARK ENVIRONMENT

The proposed lands are made up of mainly deciduous forest and conifer plantation with some areas of provincially significant wetlands and sand barrens.

The area is important for connecting wildlife habitat and supports several species at risk.

We are collecting new information about the area's natural environment, such as inventorying its plant communities, invasive species, species at risk, and other special features.
