**RE: Municipal Comments on Application of Approval of Waste Disposal Site
ESC Cares Inc. – 47 Churchill Drive, Barrie, ON
Reference Number 9549-BJ9RVS**

The City of Barrie has reviewed the application for an amendment to Environment Compliance Approval 6618-7QK7R to add all biomedical waste classes at the above noted facility.

The property municipally identified as 47 Churchill Drive is zoned General Industrial (GI) as per Comprehensive Zoning By-Law 2009-141 ('Zoning By-Law'). Permitted uses in the GI zone include a Recyclable Materials Transfer Station. A Recyclable Materials Transfer Station is defined as "a building used primarily for the collection, sorting and separation of recyclable materials, and the processing or preparation thereof in the form of densification for the efficient storage and/or shipment to a material recovery facility or directly to end users."

Based on the content in the City's Zoning By-law, the additional uses are permitted at this location, in a fully enclosed building. The existing facility is located in an industrial zoned area and is surrounded by industrial uses. No outdoor storage or accessory outdoor storage is permitted.

Subject to the comments above, the City of Barrie Development Services Department has no objection to the proposed amendment and does not request a hearing under the Environmental Protection Act.
