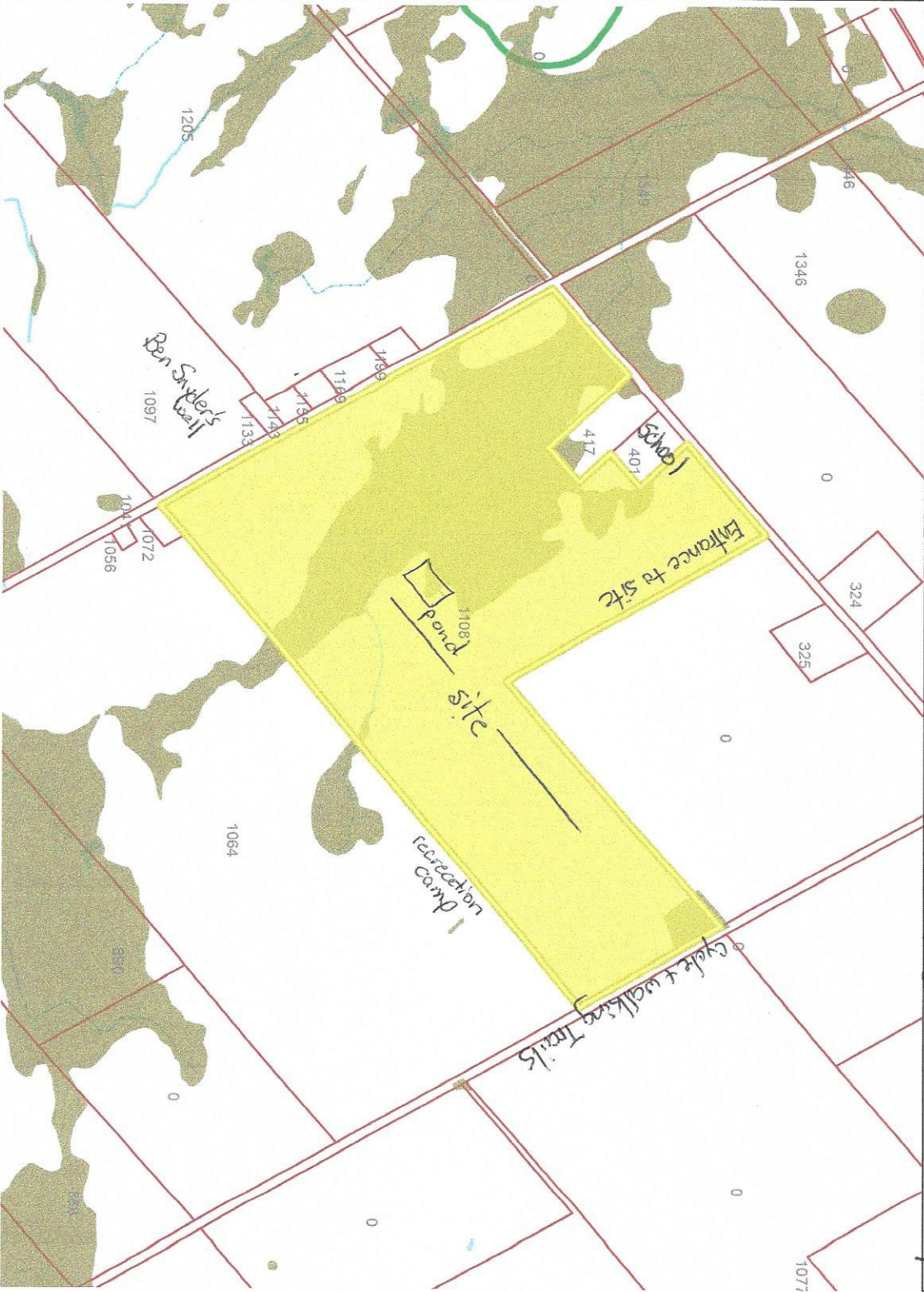

At our property at 1097 Zion Line we have an issue with water contamination I am hoping you can address.

July-Sept 2016 we got back water samples stating it is unfit to drink. This property has been family owned for 34 years and does not have a history of unfit water except in 2012 drought when it was slightly contaminated for 1 month. As it was unfit in 2016 for an extended period we contacted Health Unit (Pembroke) for advice. They sent us to Jennifer Faria (MOE Ottawa) 1-800-860-2195 ext 230. She attended our farm with Jen Bitten (MOE Ottawa ext 255). They inspected our two wells and thought the house well should be repaired but as we are building a new house we could wait because it is in a bad spot to work on at present. They inspected the barn well and recommended I test it and use it if it comes clean.

I started by testing it first and it was overgrown (very unsafe). I put in 2 cups of 65% hypochloride for 48 hrs and after pumping for 2 hrs with sump pump our test was still 2 E.coli/100 ml and 5 coliform/100 ml. At this point I did not pursue the barn well any further and I believe the two wells are very closely connected via natural aquaduct. The test the MOE girls did when they were here are as follows

E.coli 54 cfu/100ml

Total coliform 110 cfu/100ml

Total coliform Background 200 cfu/100ml

Our Health Unit test results:

Sewage spreading on land must stop by 80 April - In Nutrient Management Act

My conclusion is that this issue is directly related to the raw sewage being spread across the road on a field accessed from the Pappin RD. We did not shock any wells after Nov 01 and yet within two weeks of the sewage spreading being discontinued you

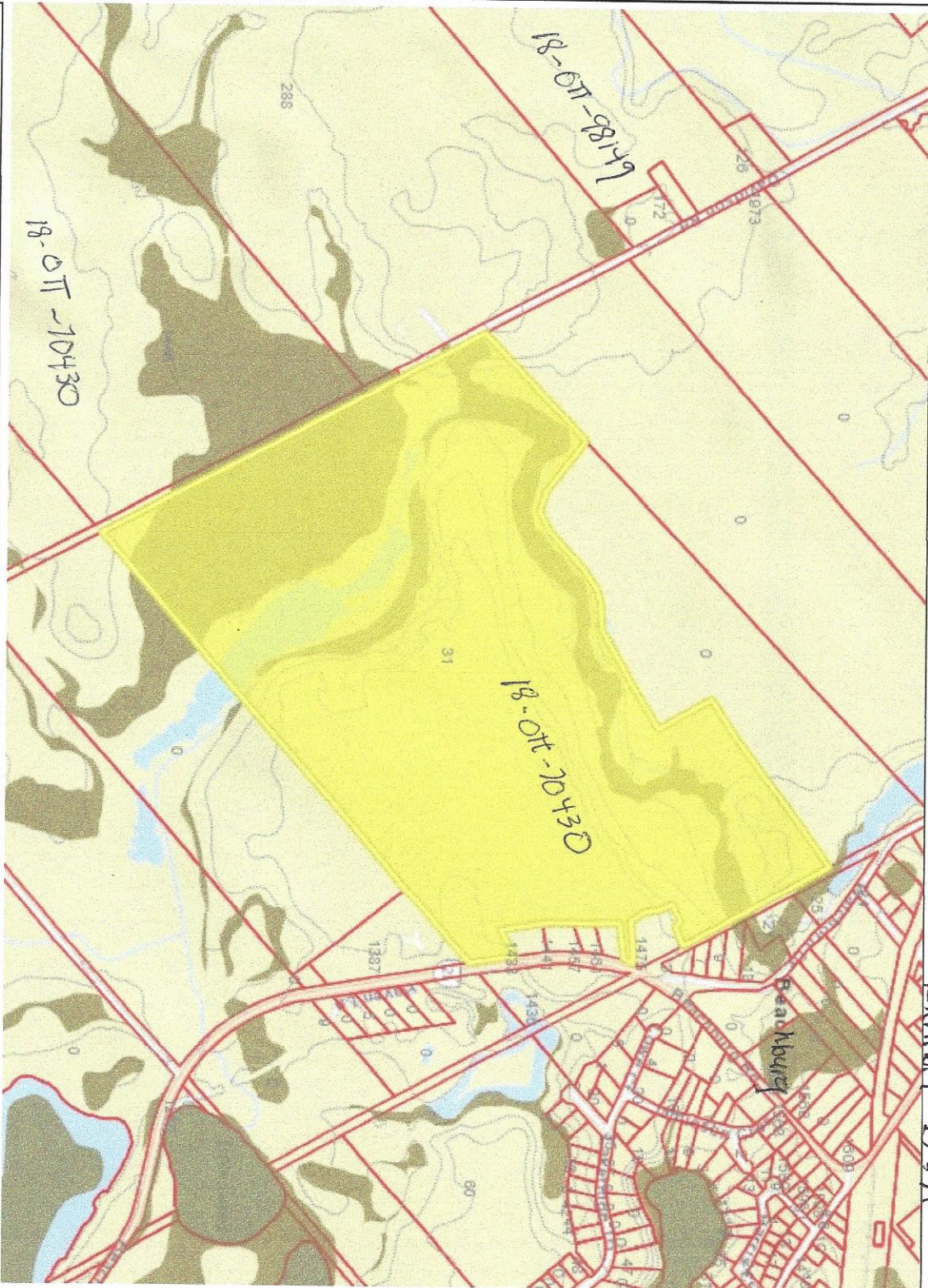
can see that the water very quickly lost most of its dangerous contamination. We are hoping that the raw sewage spreading will not continue this spring however if it does we will continue to document our water test results. I have again spoke to Jennifer this morning and she agreed to review the situation again and indicated that she would get a hydrologist involved. I am willing to share any documentation with you that I have. If you have any questions please contact me at any time.

APPLICATION IMAGE – WASTE DISPOSAL SITE CAMPBELL’S BAY CIMENT

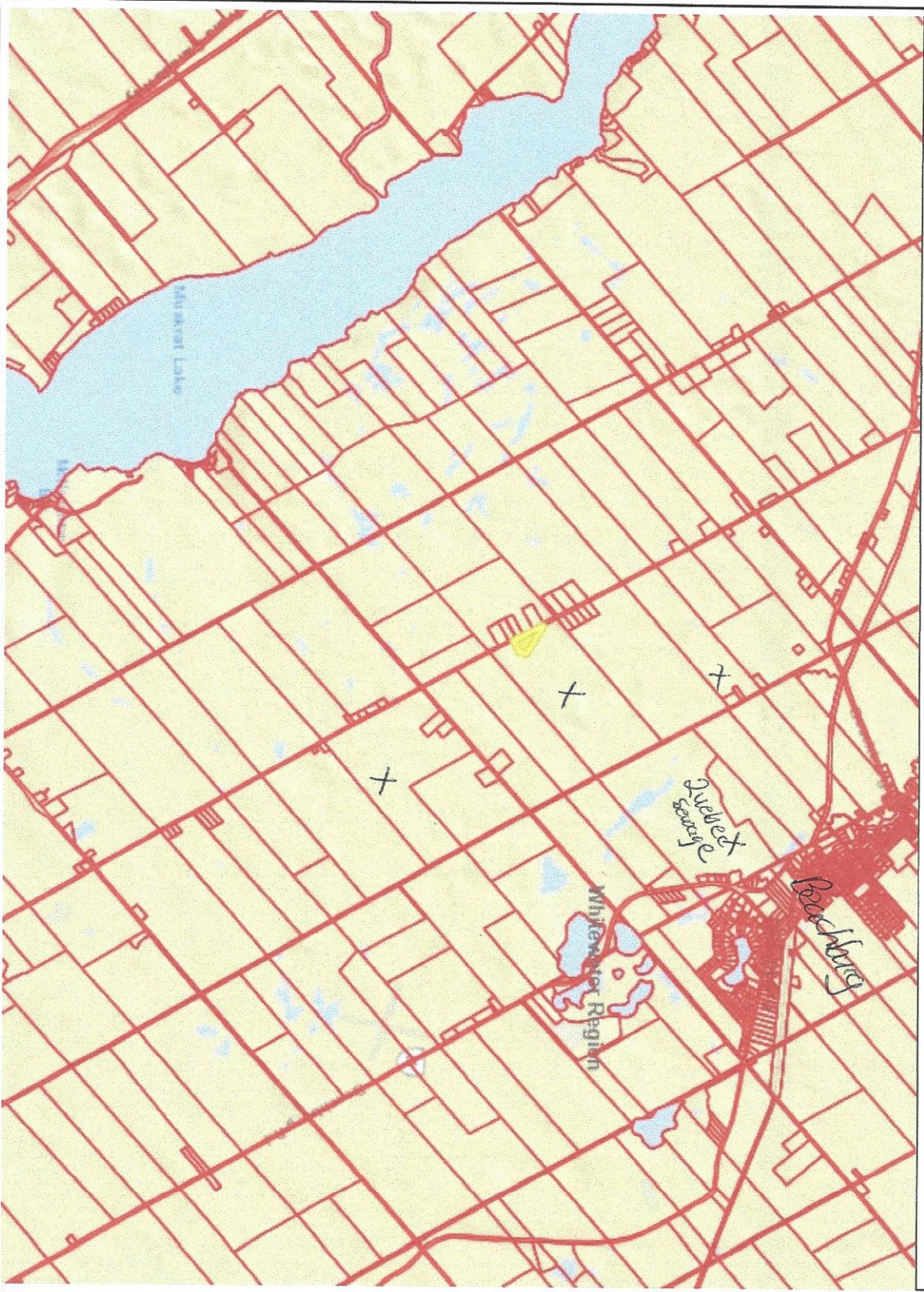
