THAT report CD-22-046 Bill 109, More Homes for Everyone Act, 2022 be received as information;

AND THAT the comments from report CD 22-046 Bill 109, along with any additional staff and Council comments, be submitted to the Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing and the Haldimand-Norfolk MPP as part of the provincial commenting period; including

- concern regarding provincial legislation that would financially penalize municipalities (and potentially impact taxpayers to offset fees that should be paid by growth) should stringent provincial development timelines not be met;
- 2. the need for increased funding resources to assist with further staff capacity requirements to meet the timelines;
- 3. clarity on timelines for agency feedback, provincial review, applicant obligations and other details about implementation of the proposed refunds;
- 4. concerns surrounding reduced public input times;

AND FURTHER THAT the province continue to further consult and work with rural municipalities, their housing authorities and service managers, non-profits and industry stakeholders on funding plans for housing and for streamlined development approvals in rural municipalities.
