Adding subsection 1(7)	City of Hamilton Staff are of the opinion that this change would enable land expropriation prior to the completion of an environmental assessment. Expropriation prior to completion of an EA may be premature given that the results of the EA may conclude that lands should not form part of the project.

Subsections 1(1)(2), 6(1.1), 7(3.1), (3.2), 7.0.1(1)-(7), 10(2)(b), 41(5)(a), 42(4)(a), 48(11)(d), 105(1)(4), 121(2)(3).	<p>City of Hamilton Staff are supportive of changes which result in increases compliance on licence plate renewals as the municipal Administrative Penalty System relies on Plate Denials for the collection of late payments.</p> <p>Changes made by the Province in 2022 which eliminated the fee associated with renewal of license plates has had a significant impact on collection of late penalties and continues to have a significant material effect on the budget and revenues of the City of Hamilton, with cumulative impacts on outstanding revenue estimated at over \$4 million to date.</p>

<p>Table to section 1 of the <i>Official Plan Adjustments act, 2023</i> is repealed and replaced with an updated table.</p> <p>Section 2 of the Act is repealed and replaced with additional modifications.</p>	<p>This effect of the proposed changes are to re-enact some of the Minister’s modifications to the approval of Official Plan Amendment No. 167 to the Urban Hamilton Official Plan that were reversed by the <i>Official Plan Adjustments Act, 2023</i>. The Minister’s modifications that are being considered for re-enactment are Modifications 17, 18, 26, 35, 36 and 40 to 47.</p> <p>These modifications were evaluated as part of staff report PED23252 and their retention was supported by staff and Council as they contribute to interpretive conformity with Provincial policies. A copy of report PED23252 is attached.</p>
